BE IT RESOLVED by the Meigs County on behalf of the State of Ohio that:

- Section I. The Meigs County reasonably expects to receive a reinbursement for the Project named R34-C30µA, C34,C3M, C7 Paving as set forth in Appendix A of the Project Agreement with the proceeds of bends to be issued by the State of Ohio.
- Section 2. The maximum aggregate principal amount of bonds, other than for cost of issuance, expected to be issued by the State of Ohio reimbursement to the local subdivision is \$121,410.
- Section 3. The Fiscal Officer of the Meigs County is hereby directed to file a onpy of this Resolution with the Meigs County for the inspection and examination of all persons interested therein and to deliver a copy of the Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.
- Section 4. The Meigs County finds and determines that all formal actions of this County concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Meigs County and that all deliberations of this County and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.
- Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from an immediately upon its adoption.
