SHERIFF'S BUDGET

Mr. Smith discussed he had emailed the Sheriff about attending the Commissioners meeting on June 18th, 2020 to go over the spending plan and received a response that the Sheriff would not be in town until after June 22nd, 2020. The Sheriff stated he would like to meet after the 4th of July which would be July 9, 2020. Mr. Will stated it would be nice to meet before the quarter is over. Mr. Ihle said cannot meet if he is not here. Mr. Will stated there was enough data to figure line items that will be over spent, if not already.

Mr. Smith proposed looking through the budget through June and comparing the difference from the original and now, stating there could have been no prediction for COVID-19 and shutting down the jail. There has been no communication from

the Sheriff or steps given in savings. Mr. Ihle stated need to do a motion to do letter or email to offer the Sheriff Resolution to appropriate the final amount of \$200,000.00 to his budget for the rest of the year. The other option would be give the original amount requested and find a way to make the amount work.

Mr. Smith asked Mr. Stanley if an email should be sent stating no more funding will be granted and also asked if this is renegotiating the budget is what should be done?

Mr. Ihle made a motion to send a letter or email with a request for the Sheriff to attend today's meeting, he did not attend; considering approval of original amount requested. We anticipate approving the final amount on June 25th, 2020; this will be the final appropriated amount. Mr. Will seconded the motion.
